

Defibrillator/AED Guidelines

A
AWARE

Ensure that people are **AWARE** of the defibrillator/AED and that enough people have the confidence to use it in an emergency.

W
WHERE

Ensure that people know **WHERE** the defibrillator/AED is located and that it is within a few minutes of a potential patient.

A
ACCESS

Ensure that people can **ACCESS** the defibrillator/AED at all times and that it is signposted and unlocked.

R
RECORD

RECORD all the defibrillator/AED information including: person responsible; equipment; deployment and training details. Record each incident when the defibrillator/AED is used.

E
EFFECTIVE

Ensure that the defibrillator/AED is **EFFECTIVE** checked and logged daily.
